# Club Registration Fact Sheet

There are 4 things that must happen for your vehicle to be legally registered.  
If any of the items below are missing or not current, you are breaching the conditions of the Club Registration Scheme and harsh penalties may apply.

- **Current Club membership** – your Membership fees must be paid
- **Current Log Book** - Membership Year page has been stamped and signed by the Club
- **Log Book entry for the day** – includes date, journey description and signature
- **SA Government registration fees paid**

### Extra Info:

The Log Book must be carried in the vehicle when driving.

Log Book must be filled out in pen before driving & must be carried in the vehicle.

You have 90 days driving per registration year, not membership year.

Anyone can sign the Log Book to drive the vehicle, not just the owner.

After midnight is another day, another entry is required in the Log Book if you are driving after 11:59PM.

The vehicle cannot be driven for fee, hire or reward.

The vehicle can be driven interstate temporarily as long as the Log Book is filled in.

If the vehicle is LHD or a Street Rod, the appropriate Certificate of Exemption must be carried in the vehicle.
